On Wednesday May 14th from 7:00 to 8:30 PM, Essco Safety Check will be available at the Serene Lake Elementary School to answer questions about our services and provide FREE toy and consumer product testing to the public.

Essco Safety Check has a goal to help people know what is in their environment. We use laboratory-grade, handheld, X-ray Fluorescence (XRF) analyzers to detect the presence of a variety of toxic substances within your home or business. We do testing to check for potential toxins such as lead, cadmium, arsenic, mercury, chlorine, PVC and many other elements.

With increasing frequency, toys and other consumer products have been recalled due to high levels of lead. As consumers become more knowledgeable of the prevalence and dangers of lead, they are also becoming more aware of the potentially adverse health effects of other toxins such as mercury, arsenic, cadmium, and chlorine.

Citizens are invited to bring up to five items; the XRF scanner provides an analysis within 60 seconds. If you would like toys or any consumer products tested for potential toxic element, or if you have any questions about our in-home inspection service, please join us at the Serene Lake Elementary School on Wednesday, May 14th between 7 PM and 8:30 PM.
